NOTICE

This is to inform all faculty members, staff, and students that in compliance with the recent directive issued by the Higher Education Department and affiliated state universities regarding the "Nasha Mukh Bharat Abhiyaan", the college is strictly enforcing a comprehensive campaign to ensure a **100% Drug-Free Campus**.

To successfully implement this policy, the following rules, directives, and monitoring mechanisms are effective immediately:

1. **Strict Prohibition:** The sale, possession, distribution, and consumption of alcohol, tobacco products, cigarettes, e-cigarettes, and any other intoxicating substances are strictly prohibited inside the college campus, surrounding institutional areas, and hostels.
2. **Formation of Anti-Drug Committees:** The institution is constituting an internal monitoring committee consisting of senior faculty members, wardens, and student representatives. This committee will conduct surprise checks across the campus, classrooms, canteens, and residential spaces.
3. **Establishment of a "Nasha Mukh Cell":** A dedicated helpline cell is being established. Students and staff can report any suspicious substance abuse activities or seek professional counseling support. Complete confidentiality will be maintained for all reported cases.
4. **Mandatory Awareness Activities:** The college will organize regular seminars, poster-making competitions, street plays (Nukkad Natak), and pledge-taking ceremonies to educate students on the ill effects of substance abuse.
5. **Strict Disciplinary Action:** Any individual (student, faculty, or staff) found violating these directives will face severe disciplinary consequences, including heavy fines, immediate suspension, or expulsion from the institution, along with legal reporting to local authorities. All students and staff members are expected to cooperate fully to maintain a healthy, safe, and clean educational environment.
